Prizes will be awarded for each Bingo and for each Blackout card. No extra credit for listening to more than one option per box - just an impressed teacher and your own listening pleasure. Only one "Regular Listening" square may be completed per week. This individual information can be found in your "Student File" under the "Lesson Assignments" tab in the "Repertoire Listening" column.
